

DUTIES OF PEER REVIEWERS

Contribution to editorial decisions

The process of Peer review assists the editor(s) of IJABR in making editorial decisions and may also assist the author in improving the quality of paper. Peer review process is an essential section of scholarly communication. IJABR strictly bind in terms of to do a fair share of reviewing.

Promptness

Promptness is the key component for the review process. If referee who feels unable to review within a time should notify to editor-In-Chief and excuse himself from the review process.

Confidentiality

Any manuscripts received for peer review must be treated as confidential documents (no disclosure to the public).

Standards of objectivity

In review process, IJABR conducts the objectivity. Strictly avoided the personal criticism with Author(s), Referees views with full of supporting documents is mandatory, rting arguments.

Acknowledgement of sources

Peer reviewers should collect and study relevant published work that non-cited by Author. Any statement that an observation, derivation, or argument had been previously reported should be accompanied by the relevant citation. The peer reviewer should also call to the editor's attention regarding the any other published paper of which they have personal knowledge.

Disclosure and conflict of interest

The supported material/Ideas from Author submission should not be used by the reviewers for their personal use/research and keep the confidentiality with them.

Peer reviewers should not consider manuscripts in which they have conflicts of interest.
